

COMPETITION RULES

CACCA DIGITAL PROJECTED IMAGES COMPRTITION

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

The DPI Interclub Competition will be conducted according to the existing CACCA competition rules except as modified herein. These modifications primarily concern image submission.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Image size will be 1024 x 768 (maximum height) pixels
- File size is to be 350 kB maximum
- Image is to be entered as a JPEG file
- Titles can be no more than 36 characters including spaces
- CACCA will not change or “correct” any images that do not conform to the specified criteria

COMPETITION PROCEDURES

- PSA standards for digital projected images will be used modified if necessary
- Projector will be calibrated and profiled before each competition
- Judging and scoring procedures will be similar/same as those currently in use in CACCA slide competitions
- The DPI competition will use the *Club Viewer* software
- The judges will be seated away from the screen 2 to 2 ½ times the longest dimension of the screen image

IMAGE SUBMISSION

- Images must be submitted through a CACCA member club as one submission
- Images must be submitted in an entry format (maker, title, etc.) specified by CACCA
- Images must be submitted by e-mail.
- Images for each monthly competition must be received by the Competition Chairman one week in advance of the CACCA regular monthly interclub competition.
